Theme: Recreation and Health

A. SHORT STORY APPRECIATION

The Enchanted Island

In teaching drama appreciation, focus on the following areas:

- Background (context) of the story
- Introduction to Shakespeare –The man and his times
- Understanding of elements of plot development (Introduction, Conflict, Rising Action, Climax, Falling Action, Resolution)
- Examination of Character traits and motivations
- Recognition of Setting and its impact on the story's plot
- Identification of Themes
- Identification and discussion of the use of literary devices utilized by the author
- Identification and interpretation of point of view
- Making connections with texts read outside the classroom

Selections:

- 1. The Taming of the Shrew/ A wild cat for a wife
- 2. The Merchant of Venice/ A pound of flesh
- 3. Julius Caesar/ Death of a dictator

4. Macbeth/ Murder at Dunsinane

B. POETRY APPRECIATION

Sunsong book 1

Teach poetry appreciation through:

- Reading types of poems for meanings and appreciation Dramatic, Lyrical and Narrative
- Identifying relationship between structure and meaning
- Commenting on effect created supported by evidence
- Making connections with poems read outside the classroom
- Understanding poetic language (poet's choice of words) to determine poet's message.
- Oral expression (correct phrasing to ensure comprehension)

Poetry

- 1. Literary devices. Any of the following NOT already done
- Rhyme
- Rhythm
- Simile
- Metaphor
- Alliteration
- Personification
- Onomatopoeia
- Rhetorical questions

Selections:

- 1. "Ballad of an Old Woman"
- 2. "The old wife and the ghost"

Assessment:

1. Short answer type questions on one of the short stories from The Enchanted Island
