CDA 10th Anniversary Poster Competition

The Child Development Agency is staging a **poster competition** as part of measures to commemorate its **10th Anniversary**. The Poster Competition is being observed under the theme, **“Protecting Children, Transforming Lives... Securing the Future.”**

Participants should create a poster depicting any of the following:

1. **Parents and communities play an important role in protecting the rights of children.**
2. **“My Vision of a Jamaica fit for Children is....”**
3. **Capture in art, CDA’s Tagline, “ Protecting Children, Transforming Lives, Securing the Future”.**

THE COMPETITION

To be eligible for the competition, children must be:

- Between the ages of **6 to 17**,
- Enrolled in elementary (**Primary or Prep**) or **Secondary/High School** in Jamaica,
- Or living in a Child Care Facility.

First and second prizes will be awarded to children in three age categories.

OTHER COMPETITION RULES

- The posters must be **11”x 17” to 18”x 24” (inches)** in size.
- Children can use **paint, crayons, pencil, coloured pencil, charcoal, pastels, magic markers, water colours, ink**, or any combination of these media.
- All artwork must be original.
- A completed entry form must accompany all entries.
- Contestants must be within the stated age range (**6 to 17**)
- Entries will become the property of the Child Development Agency and entrants will be required to relinquish all copyrights to the Child Development Agency.
- Complete the official entry form.



AGE CATEGORIES

The competition is divided into three age categories.

- **Six (6) to eight (8)**
- **Nine (9) to 13**
- **Fourteen (14) to 17**



Entries must be submitted to the **CDA Corporate Office, 48 Duke Street no later than September 30, 2014.**

Entries may also be submitted to any of CDA’s office islandwide.

Entries received after that date will not be considered.
