Focus on: key story elements that help in the depiction of the plot and theme of a story, including point of view, format: chronological/flashback; creating mood/atmosphere through description of setting and/or character(s), creating impactful beginnings (exposition), using dialogue efficiently and effectively (review dialogue format, including punctuation), sustaining suspense, building up to climax and creating unpredictable endings/endings with a twist.
